Do you have this plant in your woods?



This is wavyleaf basketgrass, a forest grass from Asia that can take over the forest floor in your woods and affect the health of Maryland forests. The Department of Natural Resources is working with landowners to remove this invader from private land, as well as eradicating it on state land. We can help you get this invasive grass off your property.

Learn about the invasive grass, its impacts on our forests, the state's Landowner Incentive Program and how it can benefit you. Hear from your neighbors who have participated in the LIP program and their experience with WLBG.
