April General Meeting

Liberty Road Volunteer Fire Company



Guest speaker Capt. Bernard Jones of the Liberty Road Volunteer Fire Company gave a presentation on the department's activities and coverage area.

He has 22 years of experience and works with 50 volunteer fire fighters. The GPCA membership area is served by both Liberty Road and Woodlawn Volunteer Companies, though their response areas do not overlap. Capt. Jones addressed the challenges of responding in the rural area and how they secure adequate water to extinguish our fires. There is a cistern for their use on Sienna Way and they have access to the Edrich ponds. They also are now licensed for a drone, and have a new engine. He reminded us that smoke detectors more than ten years old are not reliable and should be replaced. Use battery run detectors which can be easily replaced and thrown away. He also urged anyone interested to volunteer – especially young residents as the age limit is now 16 years old – and everyone can help in some way. There was a great exchange of questions, answers and participation from all our attendees. More information and upcoming events

CZMP GPCA area Zoning Petition Issue #4-011



As reported, the Planning Board work session for District 4 and 7 took place on April 18th. The Board noted the impressive number of GPCA members and residents living very near the Braglio property being petitioned who attended and voiced their objections to the requested zoning change. GPCA's written objections already were seen and reviewed by Board members, and emphasized by 4th District member Cathy Wolfson. The Planning Board voted to accept the staff recommendation against changing the zoning, thereby keeping it at RC2 for agricultural use only. The official final vote of the Planning Board will be May 16th. The process then moves to the County Council which will hear public testimonies in person throughout the month of June. The 4th District hearing is scheduled for June 6th at the New Town High School in Owings Mills, starting at 6:00. The Council's final zoning decisions are scheduled for vote on August 27th.

CAP Open House @Historic Nike Site - May 26th!

After years of work from hundreds of volunteers and generous donations the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) will open the Granite Nike site, BA-79, to the public on the fourth Sunday of month with the first opening occurring on 26 May from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. During this time tours of the site will be offered to include going into two of the magazines where the missiles were housed. While the May open house will be geared toward the Nike site, the June open house

(23 June) will be a much larger event with several local volunteer organizations hosting display tables to include Patapsco Greenway Heritage, a local model rocketry club, and GPCA. We are also hoping to host a guest speaker who will talk about the history of the Nike program and BA-79.

To prepare for the open houses there will be a volunteer work day on 18 May from 0900 to 1200. During this time we will be freshening up the site with new paint and mowing and weed-whacking the fast-growing grass and weeds.

CAP is an affiliate of the United States Air Force and, as one of its missions, provides aerospace education to its members and the public. Since the Maryland Wing CAP leases the Nike site from the state of Maryland to use as its headquarters, opening the site to the public is a great way to support this mission of educating the public on aerospace topics.

Diamond Ridge Family Park Renovation



Baltimore County is (finally) advertising for bids to replace the pedestrian bridge and stairway to Diamond Ridge Pond this spring and the design includes other improvements to the park. The existing concrete bridge abutments and staircase will be removed. A new bridge and concrete stairway will be relocated further to the east. The plan calls for restoration enhancements to Dogwood Run up and downstream of the bridge to include riffle grade controls and rock sills. The pond will be accessed by a 10' wide asphalt walkway and an ADA picnic area and parking spaces will be added. The two decks on the pond will also be replaced. Work is expected to begin before July 1, 2025.

Update on Replacement of Ben's Run Bridge at Dogwood and Hollifield Roads

Listed erroneously as Dogwood Road Bridge No. B-0072 over Dogwood Run, this bridge has been on the county's list to replace since 2004 but has been delayed because the county has been unable to acquire the land on the Quaker Hill side of the bridge from the MD Dept. of Natural Resources (DNR). Due to partial funding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the National Park Service is required to approve the property transfer from DNR. At this time county engineers expect the land acquisition to be resolved and the new bridge design is about 80% complete. Another requirement of FHWA is that the bridge must have a weight limit of 80,000 lbs to accommodate all vehicles, including tractor trailers.



However, the design does NOT include any changes to the geometry of the roadway on either side of the bridge so Quaker Hill will remain a barrier to tractor trailer traffic. The new bridge will carry two traffic lanes and include a 3 foot shoulder on the upstream side and a 6 foot shoulder on the downstream side to accommodate pedestrians. Once the design is complete it must be reviewed and accepted by FHWA and MD State Highway Administration before going out to bid. Estimated cost for the project is \$3,225,000. The county expects to advertise for bids in early 2025 and begin work that summer. No word yet on how long we should expect the bridge to be closed. Why Did the Turtle Cross the Road?

No, I'm not trying to set up a new take on that old joke with the lame punch line. Unlike the chicken, turtles aren't just trying to get to the other side, but actually have someplace to go. More on that later.



I'm sure we've all rescued a turtle or two from harm's way. In this area, the turtle that you helped was likely an Eastern Box Turtle (*Terrapene carolina*). Eastern box turtles are

the most common species of turtle in Maryland. They are characterized by their distinctive domed shell, which can range in color from brown to black, often adorned with yellow or orange markings. The plastron (underside of the shell) is hinged, allowing the turtle to close itself entirely within its shell for protection.

They are terrestrial turtles, meaning they spend most of their time on land, although they may venture into shallow water or mud for feeding or to cool off. They are relatively adaptable and can be found in a wide range of environments, from wooded areas and open pastures to suburban neighborhoods. Eastern Box Turtles are omnivorous, consuming a diet that includes insects, fruits, mushrooms, and plants. They are also known for their ability to navigate and return to their home range, displaying remarkable homing behavior.

So, why do they cross the road? Quite often they may be searching for suitable nesting sites. And, in the early summer, many females will travel far to find ideal places to lay their eggs and may often cross roads to do this. Also, there may be a localized shortage of resources which necessitates an extension of their home range.

How can we help? The best way to help a turtle cross a road is to keep humans, pets, and vehicles at bay until it can safely cross on its own without any assistance. If the turtle is moving independently from one side of the road to the other, simply keep watch from a distance. If it's safe to do so, direct vehicles around it. Be aware of your surroundings and traffic.



- Handle Turtles Carefully--If you must pick up a turtle, gently grasp the shell edge near the mid-point of the body with two hands while supporting the bottom half of the shell.
- Maintain Direction of Travel--Always move a turtle in the same direction it was traveling when you saw it. Turtles generally have a

good sense of where they are and where they're going.

- Don't Relocate the Turtle-- It's also important not to remove the turtle from its immediate territory by driving it to a local park or nature preserve. This unexpected change of scenery could leave the turtle vulnerable to disease and environmental stress. Even if you think you know a great, safe place for the turtle to go, it's best to leave it to its own devices once you've removed it from harm's way.

Eastern Box Turtles face various threats in addition to road mortality including habitat loss due to urbanization, and agricultural development. Additionally, the illegal pet trade poses a significant threat to their population. Please be on the lookout for these fascinating creatures and lend them a helping hand whenever you can.

OK, since you asked: Why did the turtle cross the road? To prove he wasn't chicken!
